Ronnie played in Switzerland in 1978, 1987 and in the 1990's and recorded songs with his good friends Alois Schillinger and Carlo Brunner.

His musical life spans over 68 years of playing Swiss music with so many musicians, playing at so many Schwingfests at Newark, Ripon, Truckee, San Diego and Los Angeles and participating in many Musikfests and Sangerfests.

He still plays the accordion and practices 5 days a week in the morning.

Obituary – Caroline Zollinger

Aelpler Gruppe Life Member, Caroline Zollinger passed in the early morning light in the San Francisco home she so loved. Caroline left this earth peacefully to join her beloved Migg who passed in February. Born in Mannedorf, Switzerland, raised by Italian parents, the family moved back to Esino, Lake Como, when Caroline was three years old. There she attended school and continued her education in Milan. At age nineteen she moved back to Gossau, Switzerland where she was employed as a master seamstress by Vonmueller in Uster.



Through her Aunt and Uncle, she was introduced to Emil Sr and Hermine Zollinger who were parents of five handsome sons and one beautiful daughter. One of them was Emil (Migg). That chance meeting resulted in their wedding December 9, 1954 in Gossau. From the start they lived their lives to the fullest, traveling extensively in their Volkswagen Beetle throughout Europe. 

Swiss Post has issued a special postage stamp to commemorate the national Guide and Scout Movement. The stamp has a face value of CHF1.10 (\$1.10), the stamp smells of smoke and marks the National Jamboree that only takes place every 14 years. The scent is released by rubbing the special coating of the stamp and evoke memories of "campfire, huge campsites and spending time together with friends"
