Pacific Cup 2022 Sailboat Race Submitted by Life Member: Heinz Baumann



Recently, we participated in the Pacific

Cup 2022, a 2000 nautical mile (2300 status miles) sailboat non-stop, open ocean race, that starts from San Francisco, California and ends in Kane'ohe, Oahu. Our crew of four consisted of Karin, Andrea, Raffi and myself.

We sailed on my 38ft sailboat under the Swiss flag. On July 4th, the race began in front of the St. Francis Yacht Club in San Francisco and headed under the Golden Gate Bridge into the Pacific



Ocean. Due to the calm conditions on the first 3 days, we only made 50 nautical miles in 36 hours and had much time to watch the whales.

Later the wind picked up and we were able to travel 140 - 170 nautical miles per day. From here on out we had our hands full with handling sails, boat duties and navigation. After 2400 nautical miles (2760 miles) at sea, we crossed the finish line! An hour later we had a warm welcome at Kane'ohe Yacht Club with about a hundred other Pacific Cup participants, families and staff members. Quite an overwhelming welcome! We finished the race in 5th place

in our fleet of 11 boats. After celebratingour successful passage to Hawaii as well as getting some well-earned rest, we set out to do repairs, reprovision and prepare the boat for our passage to Kodiak, Alaska, another 2400 nautical miles (2750 miles) on the North



Pacific. Karin left us to return back to Switzerland. We continued our adventures as a crew of three...
