Aelpler Gruppe Folklore Luncheon

On April 26th, Aelpler Gruppe held its yearly Folklore Luncheon. This year, the honoree for the event is life member Bill Bauhofer, along with his

family. The Bauhofer family goes back five generations in the United States. Joe Bauhofer Sr. came from canton Uri to the United States in 1903 and went into the milk business in Alameda. In 1921 Joe Sr.



and a partner opened the Innes-Cloverdale Dairy; a milking and processing facility in Centerville.

Another Swiss, John Wipfi Sr. immigrated from canton Uri to the East Bay (California) in 1882. He married Caroline Herger and by 1920 they bought and settled on a dairy in Irvington. The families became good friends and eventually, Bill Bauhofer Sr. married Frieda Wipfli in 1938. A year later Bill's sister, Lily married John Wipfli Jr.


A few months after Bill and Frieda wed, the Cloverdale Creamery was opened. Two years after the creamery opened, Bill Jr. was born, and sister Carol came two years after that. The Cloverdale Creamery was a gathering place for family, friends and the greater community.

Bill worked at the creamery often. He liked the business part of working and was also good at heading up building maintenance projects. It was a 12-hr. day/7 days a week job.



Cloverdale Creamery closed its doors for the last time in 2001. It was the end of an institution in Fremont, after 63 years of service at the creamery and 80 years of Cloverdale in Washington Township.

Agnes Duffner (nee Spichtig) June 4,1928-June 9,2023

Agnes was 95 years old when she passed with her two sons by her side. She was born in 1928 in the alpine village of Alpnach, Switzerland to parents Valentin and Oliva. She was the middle child of 9 siblings.



Agnes worked in restaurant service through the early 1950s in Switzerland. She worked as a nanny in Lausanne, Switzerland from 1944 to 1946, and then in England in the early and mid-1950s. Agnes then emigrated to the United States with her best friend Erika in 1956, arriving by ship in New York City and then eventually moving to the California Bay Area. Agnes took a job with the Bauhofer Family at the Cloverdale Creamery in Fremont.

Agnes met Josef Duffner, a German immigrant, at the Swiss Park, circa 1959 and married in 1960 in Reno. She had two sons, Mark and Dirk, and stayed in Fremont with her family until the death of her husband in 2004. After Josef's passing she moved to Redwood City to be closer to her grandchildren.

To her grandchildren, she was lovingly known as Grossi, a Swiss-German nickname for grandma. Her grandchildren will remember her warm hugs, her slew of quirky hats, and the many snacks she would keep stocked for visits. She will be forever remembered for her wonderfully crafted outfits with colorful matching scarves, purses, and hats.

She will be deeply missed by those who knew her. Her family and friends are grateful for the time they had with her and the memories shared with her will forever be cherished.

She is survived by her sons, Mark with wife Jeanne, and Dirk with wife Marjorie, and by her three grandchildren, RJ with wife Tessa, Taylor and Mackenzie, and by her great-grandson, Liam.

She is also survived by her beloved caregivers, Ronnie and Dina who for many years provided Agnes with wonderful care and companionship and to whom the Duffner Family will be forever grateful. We are also blessed to have had Lilia and neighbor, Mollie, who provided friendship and support for our Grossi.

A celebration of life will be held Saturday September 23, 2023 beginning at 11:00 am at The Swiss Park in Newark, California.

Limited Edition Swiss Coins

Switzerland is issuing commemorative, limited edition coins to mark the 175th anniversary of its Constitution and the founding of the modern state.

On September 12, 1848, Switzerland stepped into a new federal era with the adoption of a Constitution, which laid down the principles of how the country would be run.

Switzerland's initial birthdate is given as August 1, 1291, but it wasn't until 1848 that the Alpine starting bearing a resemblance to the way the country is run today.

To mark the event, 10,000 silver coins weighing 20 grams will be minted at a face value of CHF20 (\$22).

The coins will feature two angels bearing the Swiss coat of arms and the preamble to the Constitution on the reverse side. Some 5,000 gold coins, worth CHF50 on release, will also be minted.

On July 1 and 2, 2023, the Swiss National Bank will open its doors to the public for a tour of its headquarters in Bern.

The commemorative coins will be released to the public on the same weekend.
