

What does the Sierra Swiss Club do when it is not Schwingen Season?

They ring home MARCO ODERMATT to his 3rd consecutive World Cup overall title on Saturday, February 24th at Palisades Tahoe, as he claimed a 10th giant slalom victory in a row.



Members and friends of the Sierra Swiss Club and even those from the Swiss Consulate, Balz Abplanalp, Beat Henzen and Oliver Guggisberg,

cheered on the skiiers with their Swiss Flags and Treicheln and Glocken Schwingen Bells! Friday they paraded down the Palisades Village with their flags and Ringing Bells! Saturday and Sunday were early

mornings to get the first row spots in the stands to ring home the skiiers as they approached the finish line. It was a wonderful day under a bright sun and blue sky with the temperature approaching 50 F. While rooting for all of the skiiers and especially the Americans (3rd place River Radamus, 20th Tommy Ford, 24th Patrick Kenny) - the highlight was ringing home the 1st place finisher **Marco Odermatt** and the other top Swiss skiiers (4th Thomas Tumler, 5th Gino Caviezel, 6th Loic Meillard, 12th Justin Murisier and 14th Livio Simonet). The group even got a spot light on KCRA Chanel 3 News! I can tell you doing this all day long - you

can tell how out of shape your arms are the next day!

The 26-year-old from Switzerland has been so dominant this season that he is assured





of taking home the crystal globe for having the most points in the standings even though there are still 10 of 38 races remaining on the schedule.

Odermatt's win at the Palisades Tahoe resort boosted his total to 1,702 points, a whopping 1,001 ahead of Manuel Feller's 701. Each victory is worth 100 points, so there is no way Odermatt can be caught. Odermatt completed two runs Saturday in a combined time of 2min 11.69sec. That allowed him to finish 0.12sec ahead of Norway's Henrik Kristoffersen, who earned his first podium placing of the season. Odermatt is the reigning Olympic gold medalist and world champion in the giant slalom and has gone 9-0 in that race this season, adding onto the three in a row he picked up to end last season. He finished the two legs Saturday along the Strawpile slope in Aspen in 2 minutes, 3.20 seconds, with winds reaching 25 mph (40 kph)

The West Coast Swiss Wrestling Association Congratulates 2023 Josef L Inderbitzen Perpetual Trophy Winner BRENDEN SPAHR PORTLAND, OR

We had a total of 51 Schwingers competing in 2023 from the West Coast in the overall standings for the Perpetual Trophy. We have started with the Trophy again 13 years ago, winners have included Andrew Betschart (6x), Logan Schallberger, Frank Kaech (2x) Jakob Schallberger and Grant Widmer and now Brenden Spahr, which is our first out of California Wrestler to win the Trophy.

In fact for first time in the past 12 years the Perpetual Trophy did not go to a wrestler from the Ripon Schwinger Club, in fact for the first time ever it will go to a Schwinger from the Portland Schwinger Club. Brenden also won the Pacific Northwest Schwinger Award, which is given out to the Schwinger with the top combined scores on the Tacoma, Portland and Frances Schwingfests. Congratulations to Brenden Spahr! We hear that is is planning a trip to Switzerland to compete in some early summer Schwingfests. We can't wait to get more information so we can follow him.

We once again start our 2024 Perpetrual Trophy starting at the Imperial Valley Schwingfest. Note that all of the Schwingfests count toward the Perpetrual Trophy standings. More in the next newsletter.

The George E Morris Memorial Award for 2023 was won by *Patrick Richardson, Marcus Gonzales* and *Steven Widmer*. Patrick competed in Imperial, San Diego, Frances, Truckee, Portland, Tacoma, Newark and Ripon Schwingfests - all 8 Crown Schwingfests, and Marcus Gonzales and Steven Widmer competed at Imperial Valley, Frances, Truckee, Portland, Tacoma, Newark and Ripon Schwingfests - 7 of the 8. All three also competed in George E. Morris, home Schwingen club Imperial Valley which garnered them each an additional \$100.00 The 3 men split the pot of \$2,500.00 for 2023. This was an impressive showing all up and down the West Coast. Thank you to George Morris for perpetuating the Memorial Award in memory of his son.
